1. Meeting began at 7:30 p.m.
2. Minutes of the April 5 meeting were presented. Moved to accept: W.E.C. George, Seconded: E. Bailey Unanimously accepted as presented.
3. Discussion of letters recently received from John F. Prendiville and Paul Inglis  
D. Charter reported that in his discussion with Don Johnson (before the Selectmen's Meeting) he had told Don that they were having the same problem with dogs at the arboretum. At this time management would prefer to handle the situation without signs.  
  
A motion was made by E. Bailey and seconded by W.E.C. George, to send the Selectmen a note and our backup material with our recommendation that we post "No Dogs Allowed" signs at the 3 gates at Woodlawn and the 2 gates at Mt. Hope. Voted unanimously to send the note.
