TOPIC: EILEEN SULLIVAN – ACTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS NATURAL PLAYGROUNDS

DISCUSSION Ms. Sullivan presented a slide show on "Nature Play Spaces for Acton Schools". Discussion of a similar children's garden at Morrison Farm which would allow for more natural play involving nature and unstructured playtime. Request for CPC funds for a Natural Playground design at each of the elementary schools. Total cost approximately \$30K. Requested a letter of support from the Recreation Commissioners. TOPIC: GOWARD PLAYGROUND INSTALLATION

DISCUSSION The playground equipment installation is approximately 90% complete. The train is not completely installed and Kompan is paying for the missing parts. Ms. Fochlman spoke with Central Nurseries to inquire as to the missing part. Temporary fencing will be installed. Mr. Leo has inquired about signage. Completion depends on the upcoming weather.
