Acton Police Department Receives \$39,995 State Grant to Improve Road Safety

ACTON — Chief James Cogan is pleased to share that the Acton Police Department has been awarded \$39,995.40 in state grant funding to improve road safety.

The Healy-Driscoll Administration awarded more than \$12.4 million in funding through the Municipal Road Safety, State Agency Traffic Safety, and Underserved Communities Traffic Safety Grant Programs.

The Acton Police Department received funding through the Municipal Road Grant Safety Program. The funding will allow departments to afford road safety initiatives such as traffic safety enforcement, bicyclist and pedestrian safety enforcement, non-enforcement activities such as training or community events, and the purchase of traffic safety equipment or other community safety items such as bike helmets.

The Department will be using its funding to reinforce traffic, pedestrian and bicyclist safety measures in addition to the installation and inspection of car seats and the purchase of five hand-held speed radar units.

"Road safety programming is an extremely necessary aspect of policing," said Chief Cogan. "The Acton Police Department is fortunate to receive funding that helps bolster our road safety initiatives and keep our community safe."
